How The Stock Market Works

- Stocks can be considered units of ownership equity in a company, and gives shareholders voting rights, and can give cap
- Stocks are sold and bought in a public manner in stock exchanges (ie. NYSE)
- Prices are determined by supply and demand
- Listing a company on a stock exchange can provide liquidity, and help raise capital, but leads to higher costs and stricter regulation
